John R. Good Elementary recognizes that a child's education is a duty that is shared by the school and family. In order for our children to succeed, it is vital for all stakeholders to work together in a partnership.

Because a particular percentage of Good Elementary students are considered low income, the entire school is listed as a Title I School. Our school receives "Title I Funds" (federal money) to supplement the school's existing programs to help maximize our students' success. All Title I schools are required to implement a Parent and Family Engagement Policy. The policy is to outline an intentional plan for Parent and Family engagement. This document fulfills the State's requirement.

An annual meeting will be held to inform parents of the school's participation in Title I, to explain the Title I requirements, and the right of parents to be involved. John R. Good Elementary will invite all parents and will encourage them to attend.

Community organizations and businesses are encouraged to participate in parental involvement activities.


- ✓ The parent involvement committee will form partnerships with various city and community stakeholders.
